This is a summary of the Annual Report for the United Steelworkers Local 286 Legal Services Plan, Employer Identification Number 23-2194292 Plan No. 501. This Annual Report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Benefits under the Plan are provided through a contract with a law firm and are funded with contributions to the Plan by contributing employers.

BASIC FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$451,759 as of December 31, 2017 compared to \$277,379 as of December 31, 2016. During the plan year, the plan experienced an increase in its net assets of \$174,380. This increase includes unrealized appreciation or depreciation in the value of the plan's assets, that is, the difference between the value of the plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year or the cost of assets acquired during the year. The plan had total income of \$541,496 including employer contributions of \$523,827, earnings from investments of \$1,569 and other income of \$16,100.

The plan had total expenses of \$367,116 including \$190,126 in legal provider fees and \$176,990 in administrative expenses.

If you request a copy of the full annual report from the plan administrator, these two statements and accompanying notes will be included as part of that report. The charge to cover the copying costs given above does not include a charge for the copying of these portions of the report because these portions are furnished without charge.

You also have the legally protected right to examine the annual report at the main office of the plan at 410-24 N. 8th. Street, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania 19123, and the U.S. Department of Labor in Washington, D.C., or to obtain a copy from the U.S. Department of Labor upon payment of copying costs.
